

Product: **Recombinant Mouse GDNF**

Description	Glial Cell Line-Derived Neurotrophic Factor (GDNF) is a neurotrophic factor that is closely related to other neurotrophic factors, such as Neurturin, Persephin, and Artemin, by a common structural feature called the cysteine-knot. GDNF signals through a multicomponent system of receptors that includes RET and GFR α 1-4, to promote dopamine uptake, survival and differentiation of neurons. Alternate names: ATF-1
MW	Non-glycosylated homodimer, containing two 135 amino acid chains, with a total molecular weight of 30.2 kDa.
Physical Appearance	Sterile filtered white lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder.
Source	<i>E. coli</i>
Formulation	Recombinant mouse GDNF is lyophilized with no additives.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge vial before opening. When reconstituting the product, gently pipet and wash down the sides of the vial to ensure full recovery of the protein into solution. DO NOT VORTEX. It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized product with sterile water at a concentration of 0.1 mg/mL, which can be further diluted into other aqueous solutions.
Stability	Lyophilized product is very stable at -20°C. Reconstituted material should be aliquoted and frozen at -20°C. It is recommended that a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA) is added for long term storage.
Biological Activity	The activity is determined by the dose-dependent proliferation of C6 cells and is typically less than 1 μ g/mL.
Endotoxin Level	Measured by kinetic LAL analysis and is typically \leq 1 EU/ μ g protein.
